

2021-22 No-Cost Chipping Service for Fuel Reduction

Let us help you maintain defensible space around your home!



How to receive chipping:

- Go to our website www.firesafesdcounty.org.
- Click on tab labeled "Programs" > "No Cost Chipping."
- Click on "Sign Up" and complete all questions on the form. Click "Submit."
- Piles must be ready prior to submitting application.
- Material will not be chipped without a completed application.
- If you are without Internet access, contact Morgan Graves at the Fire Safe Council of San Diego County/Resource Conservation District of Greater San Diego at (619) 562-0096.

Preparing for the chipping crew's arrival:

- Brush that has been cleared or stacked with heavy equipment will not be chipped.
- Material including, but not limited to, palm, succulents, and poison oak will not be chipped.
- Old, matted sticks are not be eligible for chipping.
- Brush must be free of mud, rocks, and other debris.
- Maximum six-inch diameter on cut limbs.
- Piles must be stacked no more than six feet high, and have easy chipper access.
- Cut ends must face the chipper access area.
- Piles must be fully accessible for chipping equipment and crew.
- Chipped material is left on-site, not hauled away.
- Donations are appreciated to continue offering this no-cost service to the public.
